

## 8. How to use a Laptop/MAC Book to Print Wirelessly



### What is Wi-Fi Printing?

Wi-Fi printing is a convenient and flexible print facility provided to students of IT Carlow. The facility allows for sending of documents, wirelessly, to the multifunction printers from a Windows laptop or MAC book. The service costs the exact same as if printing from one of IT Carlow's own PC's.

In order to avail of this service, print drivers must first be installed on the Windows laptop or MAC book

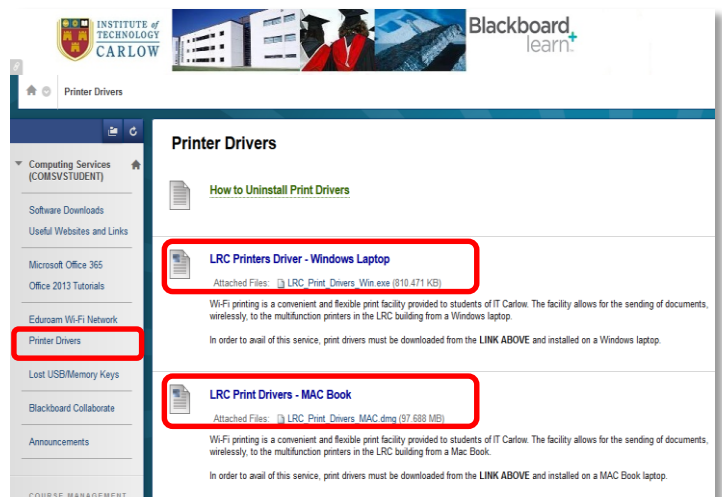
### How to install print drivers on a laptop:

Print drivers can be downloaded from the Computing Services Course on Blackboard

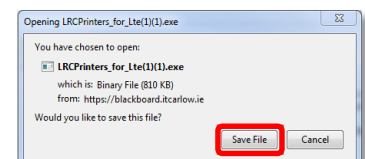
\*\*\*Please note: before proceeding please ensure your Laptop is connected to the EDUROAM Wi-Fi network\*\*\*

- Log into **BLACKBOARD**
- Click on the **COMPUTING SERVICES** Course
- Click on **PRINTER DRIVERS**
- Click on the **LRC PRINT DRIVER** for the particular device  
i.e. a Windows Laptop or MAC book.

\*\*\* Please Note: Print drivers for use by students located on the Wexford Campus are further down at the bottom of the Blackboard page\*\*\*



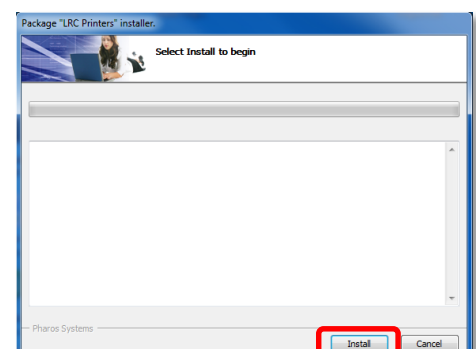
- Click on **SAVE FILE**



- Locate the downloaded printer driver in the downloads folder and double click on it:



- On the next screen click on **INSTALL**
- Once the install is finished click **FINISH**
- The printers should be visible in the printer drop down list as shown opposite
- When ready to print a document choose the required printer from the printer list as normal.
