IT CARLOW FURTHER EDUCATION PROGRESSION PATHWAYS

IT Carlow's Further Education Progression Pathways ensure greater access to Higher Education for students who successfully complete a FETAC/QQI course in a partner College of Further Education and who satisfy the certain entry criteria.

Benefits of Further Education Progression Pathways

- Offers are made in advance of CAO Round 1, normally early August in the year of entry;
- An additional route to Higher Education for students of partner Colleges of Higher Education;
- IT Carlow Progression Workshop offers students a valuable insight into higher education and college life.

Application procedure

Year 1 Entry

- Candidates must apply for entry via the CAO by 1st February in the year of entry.
- Candidates must attend the IT Carlow Progression Workshop.
- Candidates must successfully complete the full designated FETAC Award and must meet the minimum entry requirement for their chosen IT Carlow programme.

Year 2 Entry

- Candidates must apply through IT Carlow Advanced Entry process by 1st May in the year of entry.
- Candidates must attend the IT Carlow Progression Workshop.
- Candidates must successfully complete the full designated FETAC Award and must meet the minimum entry requirement for their chosen IT Carlow programme.



Eligibility for consideration under Further Education Progression Pathways

Students of partner College of Further Education must meet the specific entry criteria for their chosen programme.

Progression workshops

IT Carlow's Progression Workshop will involve student participation in generic skills training appropriate to entry to higher education as well as discipline-specific input. Attendance at this workshop is mandatory.
